The Society for the Social History of Medicine awards financial assistance for postgraduate student and early career delegates toward the cost of travel to and from a SSHM-funded conference. Successful applicants may be required to provide a report on the event after its completion, to be published in the SSHM Gazette. Applicants should note that they must be a member of the Society for the Social History of Medicine at the time of application. Applicants should also note that bursaries are awarded on the basis of financial need and date of application, are limited in number, and are not retrospectively awarded. The SSHM funds a maximum of five travel bursaries per event; each bursary may reimburse a maximum of two-thirds of travel costs. Bursary amounts are limited according to geographical bands: £240 UK only; £320 Europe and Ireland; £500 overseas.
